Kicking off the 90 Days with Jesus series, Pastor Michael set up the series around Jesus proclamation that the kingdom of God had come.

1. Before Jesus' arrival, John the Baptist was "the man!" Put yourself in his shoes what would it take to say what John did in John 3:30?
2. Why is it so important to think about what Jesus' words would have meant to those hearing them at the time he spoke them?
3. How do we hear them differently today? Should we?
4. Romans 8:15-17 talks about being more than children of God, but being heirs. Why is that such a big deal today? What does that mean to you?
5. C.S. Lewis once said that Jesus can only be either liar, lunatic, or Lord; he meant that he can't be "just a good guy," or "a really great teacher." He was either out of his mind crazy, the most successful con-man of all time, or he is what he said he was ... King and Lord. What do YOU think about Lewis' statement? Which do you think is true of Jesus?

Submitting to authority is not always the easiest thing to do. Being "under" someone isn't in our nature. Spend some time talking about what it meant that Jesus was under the authority of his Father, and what it means for us to be under Jesus' authority.
