1. Spend some time reading John 17:
 - What sticks out to you the most?
 - What themes do *you* see recurring in Jesus' thoughts?
2. Put your place in Jesus' sandals for minute ... what would *you* be thinking about if you knew you were hours away from crucifixion?
3. How do you see Jesus' call for truth and unity coming true in your life?
4. Read Colossians 1:15-20.
 1. What does it mean that he "holds all things together" in verse 17?
 2. How has he "reconciled everything to himself?"

FAMILY CHAT

Take out some glue, and if you can ... break something that you can glue back together! Before gluing it back together, talk about how each piece on its own is really useless. Spend time with your family gluing the whole back together and talk about the power and importance of the glue. Mention that the if the bond doesn't stick, you continue to glue it back together, because the whole isn't whole without all of the pieces.

Relate this to what it's like to be part of the body of Christ: unity, even when it's hard, because we ALL make up the church.
